WE ACHIEVED A GREAT DEAL OF PROGRESS TOWARD REACHING THAT GOAL WHEN WE PASSED THE UNFUNDED MANDATES LEGISLATION.

AND I THANK THE ABC FOR THE KEY SUPPORT THEY PROVIDED IN GETTING THAT BILL PASSED.

FROM WELFARE REFORM, IMPROVING OUR SCHOOLS, FIGHTING CRIME, OUR GOAL IS TO THE STATES AS MUCH FLEXIBILITY AS POSSIBLE, SO THEY CAN DESIGN A PLAN THAT BEST NEEDS THE NEEDS OF THE CITIZENS OF THEIR HOME STATE.

AND THE HISTORIC BUDGET
RESOLUTIONS PASSED BY THE
HOUSE AND SENATE ALSO SHIFT THE

IT WILL PRESERVE, IMPROVE, AND PROTECT MEDICARE, WHICH THREE

OF THE PRESIDENT'S CABINET MEMBERS SAY WILL GO BANKRUPT UNLESS ACTION IS TAKEN TO SLOW ITS RATE OF GROWTH.

IT WILL KEEP AMERICANS SAFE BY MAINTAINING FUNDING FOR NATIONAL DEFENSE, AND FOR IMPORTANT CRIME-CONTROL INITIATIVES TO AID POLICE ON THE FRONT LINES OF THE WAR AGAINST CRIME AND DRUGS.

IT WILL MAINTAIN A SAFETY NET
FOR THOSE AMERICANS IN TRUE
NEED.

AND IT WILL MAKE MONEY
AVAILABLE FOR TAX REDUCTIONS

REGULATORY REFORM

SOON WE'LL ALSO BEGIN FINAL ACTION ON AN ISSUE OF GREAT IMPORTANCE TO THE ABC, AND TO RESTORING BALANCE TO THAT WALL

I MENTIONED--AND THAT'S REGULATORY REFORM.

IF YOU BELIEVE THE RHETORIC COMING OUT OF THE WHITE HOUSE, YOU WOULD THINK THAT REGULATORY REFORM IS ADOPTED, **OUR WORKPLACES WOULD BECOME** DEATH TRAPS, AND OUR **ENVIRONMENT WOULD BE POLLUTED.** THE FACT IS THAT REGULATIONS HAVE ALLOWED US TO MAKE

STRIKER REPLACEMENT

I KNOW ANOTHER ISSUE OF GREAT INTEREST TO YOU IS STRIKER REPLACEMENT. WHEN THE DEMOCRATS HAD CONTROL OF CONGRESS, THEY TRIED EVERYTHING THEY COULD TO PASS LEGISLATION

PROHIBITING EMPLOYERS FROM HIRING PERMANENT WORKERS DURING A STRIKE. FORTUNATELY, REPUBLICANS IN THE SENATE HAVE ALWAYS BEEN ABLE TO PREVENT THE BILL FROM PASSING. AND FOR A SIMPLE REASON. IT'S A LOUSY IDEA. LAW AND CONGRESSIONAL

DECISIONS. AND HE'S DOING SO WITH AN EXECUTIVE ORDER THAT THE ECONOMIC POLICY FOUNDATION CONCLUDES WILL ANNUALLY COST OUR ECONOMY BETWEEN \$520 MILLION AND \$2 BILLION.

THERE ARE TWO WAYS TO OVERTURN THIS ILL-ADVISED EXECUTIVE ORDER. THE FIRST IS TO DO IT BY LEGISLATION. AND, IN THE SENATE, WE WOULD NEED TO HAVE

60 VOTES NECESSARY TO STOP A DEMOCRAT FILIBUSTER. WE NOW HAVE 59 COMMITTED VOTES. SO. WHEN YOU'RE UP ON THE HILL THIS WEEK, BE SURE AND MENTION THIS ISSUE TO YOUR SENATOR --ESPECIALLY IF HE OR SHE IS A DEMOCRAT.

AND THE SECOND WAY TO
OVERTURN THIS ORDER IS TO DO IT
THROUGH ANOTHER EXECUTIVE

ORDER. AND THE ONLY WAY THAT'S GOING TO HAPPEN IS IF WE ELECT A NEW PRESIDENT IN 1996. COME TO THINK OF IT, I THINK I KNOW JUST THE MAN FOR THE JOB.
