ALL OF YOU AGAIN. I JUST HAVE A
FEW THOUGHTS I WANT TO SHARE
WITH YOU TODAY, AND THEN I'D BE
HAPPY TO TAKE YOUR QUESTIONS.

FIRST, ON BEHALF OF ALL REPUBLICAN SENATORS, I WANT TO SAY THANK YOU. YOUR SUPPORT WAS CRITICAL TO HELPING US ACHIEVE OUR MAJORITY.

WE'VE JUST PASSED THE SIX
MONTH MARK OF THIS HISTORIC
SESSION, AND I THINK YOU CAN BE
VERY PROUD OF THE WORK OF THE
NEW MAJORITY YOU HELPED TO
BRING ABOUT.

WE BEGAN LAST JANUARY BY
PASSING THE CONGRESSIONAL
ACCOUNTABILITY ACT, WHICH WILL

WE PUT AN END TO THE PRACTICE

WE TOOK THE FIRST STEP TO REFORMING A CIVIL LITIGATION SYSTEM THAT IS OUT OF BALANCE, OUT OF CONTROL, AND OUT OF COMMON SENSE.

IN THE WAKE OF THE TERRIBLE
TRAGEDY IN OKLAHOMA CITY, WE

INTERFERENCE IN THAT FAST GROWING INDUSTRY.

AND, OF COURSE, WE PASSED A
HISTORIC BUDGET RESOLUTION THAT
SETS AMERICA ON A SEVEN YEAR
PATH TO A BALANCED BUDGET.

THIS IS JUST A PARTIAL LIST OF
LEGISLATION WE HAVE PASSED THIS
SESSION. ALL IN ALL, NOT A BAD
START.

AND LET ME ENSURE THE AMERICAN PEOPLE IT IS JUST THAT.

A START. I KNOW AND REPUBLICANS KNOW WE HAVE MUCH TO DO BEFORE THE END OF THIS FIRST SESSION.

THIS INCLUDES REGULATORY
REFORM. WELFARE REFORM. A
TOUGH ANTI-CRIME BILL. A
CONGRESSIONAL GIFT BAN AND
LOBBY REFORM. AND THE

APPROPRIATIONS BILLS, WHICH WILL OFFER FINAL PROOF THAT WE ARE SERIOUS ABOUT BALANCING THE BUDGET. AND SPEAKING OF THAT, WE HAVEN'T GIVEN UP ON PASSING THE BALANCED BUDGET AMENDMENT.

WANT TO SHARE IS THAT WHILE WE HAVE ACCOMPLISHED A GREAT DEAL, WE COULD HAVE

ACCOMPLISHED MUCH MUCH MORE
IF WE HAD A PRESIDENT WHO
SHARED OUR GOALS AND OUR
MISSION OF REINING IN THE FEDERAL
GOVERNMENT AND RETURNING
POWER TO OUR STATES, OUR CITIES,
AND OUR PEOPLE.

AS WITH PAST TRUST MEETINGS,

FIRST, LET ME SAY I AM VERY
GRATEFUL FOR THE SUPPORT I HAVE
RECEIVED ACROSS AMERICA IN THE
PAST FEW MONTHS.

I'M SURE YOU'VE SEEN THE SAME
POLLS THAT I SEE. IF YOU HAVEN'T,
I 'D BE HAPPY TO SHARE THEM WITH
YOU. THE NUMBERS ARE VERY

ENCOURAGING. OUR FUND RAISING
HAS BEEN VERY ENCOURAGING-ALTHOUGH WE'RE STILL A LONG
WAY FROM THE POINT WHERE WE
TURN DOWN CONTRIBUTIONS.

AND I'M VERY PROUD OF THE NUMBER OF ENDORSEMENTS I'VE RECEIVED FROM SENATORS, MEMBERS OF CONGRESS, GOVERNORS, STATE LEGISLATORS, AND STATE, COUNTY, LOCAL

OFFICIALS, AND MANY IN THIS AUDIENCE.

I ALSO KNOW, AS WILL ROGERS SAID, THAT THE SUREST WAY TO CRUSH YOUR LAURELS IS TO SIT ON THEM. AND I DON'T INTEND TO DO MUCH SITTING IN THIS CAMPAIGN.

SOME HAVE WRITTEN AND SAID
THAT "IT'S BOB DOLE'S TURN."
THAT I SHOULD RECEIVE THE

NOMINATION FOR MY PAST SERVICE
TO OUR PARTY.

AND IF YOU'RE SUPPORTING ME BECAUSE YOU BELIEVE THAT, THEN I'M HAPPY TO HAVE YOUR SUPPORT. BUT I WOULD MUCH RATHER HAVE YOUR SUPPORT NOT BECAUSE OF WHAT I'VE DONE IN THE PAST--BUT BECAUSE OF WHAT I'LL DO IN THE FUTURE.

THROUGHOUT THIS CAMPAIGN, I'VE TALKED ABOUT THE FUTURE --THE FUTURE OF OUR COUNTRY...THE FUTURE OF OUR CHILDREN AND GRANDCHILDREN. AND I'VE **OUTLINED MY PLANS FOR MAKING** THAT FUTURE BETTER, SAFER, AND FULL OF MORE OPPORTUNITY. AND THAT'S WHAT I INTEND TO KEEP ON DOING.

I'LL CONTINUE TO TALK ABOUT THE NEED TO REIN IN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, AND TO RETURN POWER TO OUR STATES, OUR CITIES, AND OUR PEOPLE. TO SOME THAT'S A NEW AND NOVEL IDEA. BUT IT'S AN IDEA THAT CAN BE FOUND IN THE 10TH AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION, WRITTEN IN HIS HISTORIC CITY.

I'LL CONTINUE TO TALK ABOUT THE VALUES--OR LACK OF THEM--IN ENTERTAINMENT INDUSTRY. THE AND THE IMPACT THAT INDUSTRY HAS ON OUR CHILDREN. NO DOUBT ABOUT IT, I'VE TAKEN SOME SHOTS MY CALL TO HAVE FOR INDUSTRY CLEAN UP ITS ACT, AND FOR THE FACT THAT I WAS WILLING TO NAME NAMES. ONE RAP GROUP

EVEN PUT OUT A VIDEO WHERE THEY
BURN A DOLE FOR PRESIDENT SIGN.

IF THAT'S ALL THEY ADVOCATED BURNING, THEN I WOULDN'T HAVE A PROBLEM. BUT SOME SONGS AND VIDEOS ALSO ADVOCATE BURNING DOWN OUR SOCIETY. AND THAT'S WHERE WE SHOULD DRAW THE LINE.

AND I'LL ALSO CONTINUE TO TALK
ABOUT AMERICA'S ROLE IN THE
WORLD. FOREIGN POLICY WASN'T

MUCH OF AN ISSUE IN 1992--BUT I THINK IT WILL BE A VERY IMPORTANT ONE IN 1996. AND FOR GOOD REASON.

THE FACT IS THAT UNDER THE CLINTON ADMINISTRATION, AMERICA'S PRESTIGE IS ON THE DECLINE. OUR WORD IS LESS RESPECTED. AND THE GOAL OF A SAFER, MORE DEMOCRATIC 21ST CENTURY IS SLIPPING AWAY.

TODAY, THE RUSSIANS ARE SENDING NUCLEAR TECHNOLOGY TO IRAN.

THE CHINESE ARE SENDING
BALLISTIC MISSILES TO THE GULF.

WE'RE SENDING U.S. TAXPAYERS
DOLLARS TO NORTH KOREA, WHILE
IGNORING OUR SOUTH KOREAN
ALLIES.

WHILE THE GENOCIDE CONTINUES
IN BOSNIA, WE CONTINUE TO TAKE

OUR MARCHING ORDERS FROM THE UNITED NATIONS.

AND WE'RE CUTTING DEALS WITH CASTRO TO SEND FREEDOM-SEEKING CUBANS BACK TO TYRANNY.

THE WORLD IS IN NEED OF
LEADERSHIP, AND WHERE IS THE
UNTIED STATES? WE'RE MIRED IN
INDECISION. WE'RE CONSTANTLY
CHANGING OUR POLICIES,

CONFUSING OUR ALLIES, AND EMBOLDENING OUR ENEMIES.

MAKE NO MISTAKE ABOUT IT: THE STRENGTH AND COMMITMENT OF THE UNITED STATES WILL DETERMINE THE FATE OF THE NEXT CENTURY JUST AS IT HAS THIS ONE. AS I SAID ON APRIL 10, AMERICA NEEDS A PRESIDENT WHO KNOWS WHAT MADE AMERICA GREAT, WHO KNOWS WHAT HAS BEEN SACRIFICED TO KEEP US FREE, AND WOULD DO ALL IN HIS POWER TO LEAD AMERICA BACK TO HER PLACE IN THE SUN.

MY FRIENDS, I HAVE BEEN TESTED IN MANY WAYS IN MY LIFE. I AM NOT AFRAID TO LEAD, AND I KNOW THE WAY. I WOULD LIKE TO HELP **COMPLETE IN 1996 WHAT WE BEGAN** IN 1994. BUT I NEED YOUR HELP. TOGETHER WE CAN REIN IN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, RECONNECT OUR INSTITUTIONS WITH OUR VALUES, AND REASSERT AMERICA'S INTERESTS AROUND THE WORLD.
