VIOLENT CRIMINALS ARE ONLY 1/5TH AS LIKELY TO SERVE THEIR FULL SENTENCE TODAY AS THEY WERE IN THE 1960'S.

CONVICTED RAPISTS SERVE, ON AVERAGE, ONLY 5 YEARS IN PRISON. DRUG TRAFFICKERS ONLY TWO. AND, WHEN THEY GET THERE, THEIR IDEA OF HARDSHIP IS NOT HAVING A REMOTE CONTROL FOR THE COLOR TV.

THE BEST PREVENTION PROGRAM FOR CRIMINALS I KNOW IS A PRISON CELL. SOMEONE SITTING BEHIND BARS CAN'T TERRORIZE A SINGLE LAW-ABIDING CITIZEN. THAT'S WHY A 20-YEAR SENTENCE SHOULD MEAN JUST THAT--20 YEARS, NOT 5 OR 10. AND WHY SHOULD WE FAVOR EARLY PAROLE FOR ANY MURDERER, WHEN THERE CAN NEVER BE PAROLE FOR A **MURDER VICTIM?**

I'VE BEEN ASKED "HOW MUCH PRISON SPACE DO WE NEED?" MY ANSWER IS AS MUCH AS IT TAKES TO PUT SPACE BETWEEN HARD CORE CRIMINALS AND LAW-ABIDING AMERICANS.

SO, IF YOU'RE LOOKING FOR A PRESIDENT WHO WOULD SLAM-DUNK CRIMINALS BY PUTTING THEM BEHIND BARS RATHER THAN BY ENROLLING THEM IN MIDNIGHT BASKETBALL PROGRAMS, THAN BOB DOLE IS YOUR MAN.

AND LET ME END THIS EVENING BY INTRODUCING TWO TRUE AMERICAN HEROES IN THE FIGHT AGAINST **TWO AMERICANS WHO** CRIME. **TURNED A HORRIBLE TRAGEDY INTO** LEGISLATION THAT WILL SAVE LIVES ACROSS THIS COUNTRY. THEY ARE MAUREEN AND RICH KANKA OF HAMILTON TOWNSHIP.

YOU KNOW THEIR STORY. A TWICE-

CONVICTED SEX OFFENDER WAS RELEASED ONTO THE STREETS AFTER SERVING ONLY 6 YEARS OF A 10 YEAR SENTENCE. HE RETURNED TO HIS OLD NEIGHBORHOOD, AND THE KANKA'S 7 YEAR OLD DAUGHTER, MEGAN, TRAGICALLY BECAME HIS NEXT VICTIM.

AND MAUREEN AND RICH SPOKE OUT. THEY SAID THAT COMMUNITIES AND NEIGHBORHOODS

HAD A RIGHT TO KNOW WHEN SEXUAL PREDATORS WERE LET OUT ON THEIR STREETS, PUTTING CHILDREN AT RISK.

SO THEY WENT TO THE NEW JERSEY LEGISLATURE AND ASKED THEM TO PASS A BILL GIVING COMMUNITIES ACCESS TO RECORDS OF CONVICTED SEX OFFENDERS. AND YESTERDAY WAS A BIG DAY

FOR MAUREEN AND RICH, AND A BIG DAY FOR ALL LAW-ABIDING CITIZENS.

FIRST, AS YOU KNOW, THE NEW JERSEY SUPREME COURT SAID THAT THE "MEGAN'S LAW" PASSED BY THE NEW JERSEY LEGISLATURE WAS CONSTITUTIONAL.

AND SECOND, MAUREEN JOINED NEW YORK GOVERNOR PATAKIAS HE SIGNED A BILL THAT MADE NEW YORK THE 47TH STATE WITH SOME FORM OF "MEGAN'S LAW" ON THE BOOKS.

LAST YEAR, I WAS PROUD TO JOIN WITH DICK ZIMMER, THE OUTSTANDING CONGRESSMAN FROM NEW JERSEY'S 12TH DISTRICT, IN AUTHORING LEGISLATION WHICH PLACED THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT ON THE SIDE OF THOSE WHO BELIEVE

THAT COMMUNITIES HAVE A RIGHT TO PROTECT THEMSELVES.

SO, LET ME END BY SAYING THAT TONIGHT, WHEN YOU GO HOME, I WANT YOU TO SAY A PRAYER FOR MEGAN, AND I WANT YOU SAY A PRAYER OF THANKS FOR THE COURAGE AND PERSEVERENCE OF MAUREEN AND RICH KANKA.
