**\*IT'S AN HONOR TO STAND  
ALONGSIDE YOUR CURRENT  
GOVERNOR, AND TWO OF YOUR  
FORMER GOVERNORS.**

**\*I'M REMINDED OF THE WORDS OF  
A FORMER KANSAS GOVERNOR--THE  
GREAT ALF LANDON. ALF SAID,  
"THERE ARE SOME SMART PEOPLE IN**



**WASHINGTON, BUT THERE ARE MORE  
OF 'EM IN KANSAS."**

**\*AND THERE'S NO DOUBT THAT  
THERE ARE ALSO MORE OF THEM IN  
ILLINOIS.**

**\*THAT'S A FACT THAT THIS  
CONGRESS HAS TRIED TO KEEP IN  
MIND THESE PAST SEVEN MONTHS.**

**\*AS YOU KNOW, CONGRESS IS  
NOW TAKING A FEW WEEKS OFF.  
AND USUALLY THAT'S GOOD NEWS,**

**BECAUSE FOR MUCH OF THE PAST 40  
YEARS, CONGRESS BELIEVED THAT  
"WASHINGTON KNEW BEST," AND  
THEY SPENT TOO MUCH, TAXED TOO

**\* BUT WE ALSO KNOW THAT THE  
FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IS TOO BIG,  
TOO BUREAUCRATIC, SPENDS TOO  
MUCH OF YOUR MONEY, AND MAKES  
TOO MANY DECISIONS THAT ARE  
BEST LEFT TO OUR STATES, OUR  
CITIES, AND TO YOU.**

**\* AND OUR PRIORITIES HAVE BEEN  
TO REIN IN THE GOVERNMENT, TO**

**CUT REGULATIONS, TO REDUCE  
YOUR TAX BURDEN, TO BALANCE  
THE BUDGET, AND TO GIVE YOU THE  
ABILITY TO MAKE DECISIONS THAT  
AFFECT YOU, YOUR BUSINESS, AND  
YOUR FAMILY.**

**\*WE'VE MADE A LOT OF  
PROGRESS--BUT WE HAVE MUCH  
MORE WORK TO DO. AND I HAPPEN  
TO BELIEVE THAT IF WE ARE TO  
SUCCEED IN OUR EFFORT, WE NEED A**

**\*AND I HAVE SOMEONE IN MIND  
WHO WILL DO JUST THAT.**

**\*LET ME JUST LEAVE YOU TODAY  
WITH STORY ABOUT SOMETHING  
THAT TOOK PLACE RIGHT HERE IN  
SPRINGFIELD 143 YEARS AGO. I TELL  
THIS STORY BECAUSE IT SAYS A LOT  
ABOUT SPRINGFIELD. AND IT SAYS A  
LOT ABOUT AMERICA.**

**\* A MAN FROM HUNGARY NAMED GOVERNOR LAZLO KOSSUTH WAS ONE OF THE LEADERS OF THE EFFORT IN THE MID 19TH CENTURY TO GIVE HIS COUNTRY INDEPENDENCE FROM RUSSIA.**

**\* AND IN 1852, GOVERNOR KOSSUTH WAS TRAVELING THROUGH THE UNITED STATES, SPEAKING ABOUT THE PEOPLE OF HUNGARY,**

**AND THEIR DESPERATE STRUGGLE  
FOR FREEDOM.**

**\* AND ONE PLACE HE VISITED WAS  
SPRINGFIELD, WHICH WAS THEN ON  
THE EDGE OF THE FRONTIER.**

**\* A TOWN MEETING WAS CALLED  
BY SOME OF THE COMMUNITY'S  
RESPECTED CITIZENS, INCLUDING A  
FELLOW NAMED ABRAHAM LINCOLN.**

**\* AND THE HUNGARIAN LEADER'S  
REMARKS TO THE MEETING STARTED**

**A DEBATE AMONG THE PEOPLE OF  
SPRINGFIELD AS TO AMERICA'S ROLE  
IN THE WORLD.**

**\*EVENTUALLY, A VOTE WAS  
TAKEN. AND THE FINAL RESOLUTION  
STATED THAT "IT IS THE DUTY OF  
THE UNITED STATES...(TO STAND) IN  
FAVOR OF ANY PEOPLE WHO MAY BE  
STRUGGLING FOR LIBERTY IN ANY  
PART OF THE WORLD."**

STAND FOR LIBERTY. WE ARE THE

TO WORKING WITH ALL OF YOU TO  
ENSURE THAT NEVER CHANGES.**
