*Audience of 300-400 NADA members. They requested a preview of what Congress will do the remainder of the year.

*Attached draft focuses on GOP's four themes. It also mentions estate tax reform (which NADA has enthusiastically endorsed) and phase-out of "luxury tax," which is a NADA priority, but on which you have not taken a stand. GOOD MORNING. IT'S A PLEASURE TO BE HERE. I JUST HAPPENED TO BE DRIVING BY, SAW ALL THE PEOPLE, AND FIGURED THERE WAS EITHER A CONVENTION HERE, OR COLIN POWELL WAS SIGNING BOOKS.

I'VE SPOKEN TO THIS GROUP ON MANY OCCASIONS. BUT THIS IS THE FIRST TIME I'VE SPOKEN TO YOU WHEN REPUBLICANS HAVE CONTROLLED BOTH HOUSES OF CONGRESS. NOW I KNOW THIS IS A BI-PARTISAN AUDIENCE, AND I DON'T WANT TO BE TOO PARTISAN TODAY. BUT I JUST WOULD SUGGEST THAT AS SMALL BUSINESSMAN, AND AS TAXPAYERS, YOU CAN BE PROUD OF THE JOB THIS CONGRESS IS DOING.

WE ARE KEEPING OUR WORD TO THE AMERICAN PEOPLE. WE ARE REINING IN THE GOVERNMENT. WE ARE RETURNING POWER TO OUR STATES AND TO OUR PEOPLE. WE ARE CUTTING THE

BUREAUCRACY. WE DID MAKE CONGRESS LIVE UNDER THE SAME LAWS WE IMPOSE ON EVERYONE ELSE. WE DID PUT AN END TO UNFUNDED MANDATES.

IT HASN'T BEEN EASY. THERE ARE STILL THOSE IN THE WHITE HOUSE AND IN CONGRESS WHO BELIEVE THAT GOVERNMENT HAS ALL THE SOLUTIONS, AND THAT BUREAUCRATS SHOULD MAKE ALL THE DECISIONS AFFECTING YOUR BUSINESS AND YOUR LIFE.

AND SINCE WE HAVE TO GET 60 VOTES TO PASS ANYTHING IN THE SENATE, THE FORCES OF THE STATUS **QUO HAVE BEEN ABLE TO BLOCK A FEW** ITEMS ON OUR AGENDA. WE CAME UP ONE VOTE SHORT ON THE BALANCED BUDGET AMENDMENT. WE'RE STILL **SEARCHING FOR A FEW MORE VOTES TO** PASS LEGISLATION TO REFORM OUR REGULATORY PROCESS. THE SENATE BILL ON TORT REFORM IS NOT AS STRONG AS THE HOUSE BILL.

BUT WE HAVEN'T GIVEN UP ON ANY OF THOSE ISSUES. AND THE REAL TEST OF THIS CONGRESS WILL COME IN THE NEXT 60 DAYS. IN FACT, SPEAKER GINGRICH SAYS THAT THE NEXT 60 DAYS WILL BE AS IMPORTANT TO THE FUTURE OF AMERICA AS ANY IN THE PAST 60 YEAR.

AND HERE ARE THE FOUR GOALS WE PLAN TO ACHIEVE IN THE NEXT 60 DAYS. FIRST, WE WILL PUT AN END TO AMERICA'S FAILED WELFARE SYSTEM, AND REPLACE IT WITH ONE BASED ON THE PRINCIPLES OF WORK AND PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY.

IN FACT, WE'LL TAKE A BIG STEP IN THAT DIRECTION THIS AFTERNOON, WHEN THE SENATE WILL PASS WELFARE REFORM LEGISLATION.

OUR "WORK OPPORTUNITY ACT" PROVIDES WORK, HOPE, AND OPPORTUNITY TO AMERICANS TRAPPED

IN A FAILED SYSTEM. OUR PLAN REQUIRES ABLE-BODIED ADULT WELFARE RECIPIENTS TO WORK. NO MORE UNLIMITED WELFARE, AND NO EXCUSES.

IT STRENGTHENS FAMILIES, AND REQUIRES PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY. IT REDUCES FEDERAL WELFARE SPENDING, AND TRANSFERS AUTHORITY FROM WASHINGTON, D.C. TO THE STATES.

AFTER ALL, MY HOME STATE OF KANSAS AND YOUR HOME STATES ARE VASTLY DIFFERENT. AND WE BELIEVE IT MAKES SENSE TO GIVE THE GOVERNORS OF THOSE STATES--AS WELL AS THE OTHER 48--THE FLEXIBILITY TO CREATE WELFARE PROGRAMS THAT BEST MEET THE NEEDS OF THEIR CITIZENS.

AFTER THE SENATE BILL PASSES, WE'LL GET TOGETHER WITH THE HOUSE TO IRON OUT A FEW DIFFERENCES, AND THEN WE'LL SEND IT TO THE PRESIDENT.

DURING THE 1992 CAMPAIGN, PRESIDENT CLINTON PROMISED TO "END WELFARE AS WE KNOW IT." HE HASN'T LIFTED A FINGER TO MAKE THAT GOAL A REALITY, BUT HE CAN DO SO BY SIGNING OUR BILL.

OUR SECOND GOAL FOR THE NEXT 60 DAYS IS TO PRESERVE, PROTECT, AND STRENGTHEN MEDICARE.

ACCORDING TO THE MEDICARE TRUSTEES--WHICH INCLUDES THREE MEMBERS OF THE PRESIDENT'S CABINET--MEDICARE WILL GO BANKRUPT WITHIN SEVEN YEARS.

EVER SINCE THEN, REPUBLICANS HAVE BEEN SEARCHING FOR A SOLUTION, AND PRESIDENT CLINTON HAS BEEN SEARCHING FOR A POLITICAL **ISSUE. HE HAS NO PROGRAM TO SAVE** MEDICARE. ALL HE IS A "MEDISCARE" INTO PLAN TO FRIGHTEN SENIORS THINKING REPUBLICANS ARE OUT TO TAKE AWAY MEDICARE.

THE FACT IS THAT OUR PLAN WILL INCREASE HEALTH CARE OPTIONS FOR

AMERICA'S SENIORS, AS WELL AS INCREASING AVERAGE SPENDING PER BENEFICIARY FROM \$4,800 THIS YEAR TO \$6,700 IN THE YEAR 2002.

DESPITE THAT FACT, THE WHITE HOUSE KEEPS ACCUSING REPUBLICANS OF "CUTTING" MEDICARE. ONLY IN WASHINGTON WOULD GOING FROM \$4,800 TO \$6,700 BE DEFINED AS A "CUT."

GOAL #3 IS TO BALANCE THE BUDGET. HOUSE AND SENATE

REPUBLICANS HAVE AGREED ON A HISTORIC SEVEN YEAR PLAN TO BALANCE THE BUDGET, AND TO END THE MORTGAGING OF THE FUTURE OF OUR CHILDREN AND GRANDCHILDREN. PRESIDENT CLINTON FOUGHT THE **BALANCED BUDGET AMENDMENT, BUT** THEN JUMPED ABOARD WITH WHAT HE BILLED AS A TEN YEAR PLAN TO BALANCE THE BUDGET. THE ONLY **PROBLEM IS THAT THE CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET OFFICE SAYS IT WOULD LEAD**

TO BIGGER DEFICITS THAN WE HAVE TODAY.

BALANCING THE BUDGET INVOLVES SOME TOUGH, CONTROVERSIAL CHOICES. AND SO DOES PRESERVING, PROTECTING, AND STRENGTHENING MEDICARE. BUT LEADERSHIP MEANS HAVING THE COURAGE TO I OOK **BEYOND THE NEXT OPINION POLL, AND** TO LOOK AT THE NEXT GENERATION OF AMERICANS. AND THAT'S WHAT I'M COMMITTED TO DO.

OUR FOURTH AND FINAL GOAL FOR

THE NEXT 60 DAYS IS TO CUT TAXES. AND I BELIEVE A TAX CUT FOR AMERICA'S FAMILIES--AND A REDUCTION IN THE CAPITAL GAINS TAX RATE--ARE JUST THE FIRST STEPS.

I WANT TO MAKE OUR TAX SYSTEM FAIRER, FLATTER, AND SIMPLER, AND WITH LOWER RATES. AND I'VE ADVOCATED THROWING OUT OUR ENTIRE TAX SYSTEM, AND STARTING OVER FROM SCRATCH. BUT WE MUST BE CAREFUL TO ENSURE THAT A NEW

TAX SYSTEM DOES NOT SHIFT THE TAX BURDEN TO THE MIDDLE CLASS.

THROWING OUT OUR TAX SYSTEM MIGHT TAKE A WHILE. BUT IN THE MEANTIME, WE CAN MAKE SOME PROGRESS BY DRASTICALLY REDUCING THE ESTATE TAX, SO THAT AMERICANS WHO INVEST A LIFETIME OF SWEAT AND TOIL TO BUILD A FAMILY BUSINESS LIKE AN AUTOMOBILE DEALERSHIP, WILL BE ABLE TO PASS THE BUSINESS ON TO THEIR CHILDREN--WITHOUT FACING CRIPPLING TAX RATES.

AND LET ME SAY THANK YOU TO THE NATIONAL AUTOMOBILE DEALERS ASSOCIATION FOR THEIR SUPPORT OF MY ESTATE TAX LEGISLATION.

I UNDERSTAND THAT YOU ARE ALSO **CONCERNED ABOUT THE CONTINUATION** OF THE EXCISE TAX ON SO-CALLED "LUXURY" AUTOMOBILES, AND ARE URGING CONGRESS TO PHASE OUT THE TAX OVER THE NEXT FIVE YEARS. WE ARE ANALYZING A MYRIAD OF TAX ISSUES THAT NEED TO BE ADDRESSED. AND WILL CERTAINLY LOOK SERIOUSLY

AT THIS ONE.

BALANCING THE BUDGET AND REDUCING TAXES SHOULD BE DONE, IT CAN BE DONE, AND IT WILL IMPROVE AMERICA'S ECONOMY AND INCREASE JOB CREATION.

THE WHITE HOUSE IS NOW PREDICTING 2.5% GROWTH FOR THE REST OF THE CENTURY. THEY CONGRATULATE THEMSELVES, BECAUSE IN THEIR VIEW 2.5% GROWTH REPRESENTS THE OUTER LIMIT OF AMERICA'S ECONOMIC POTENTIAL. OUR WHOLE HISTORY TELLS US THAT AMERICA CAN DO BETTER, SINCE WORLD WAR II, OUR ECONOMY HAS AVERAGED 3% GROWTH. DURING THE REAGAN YEARS, WE AVERAGED NEARLY 4% GROWTH.

WHAT IS IT ABOUT AMERICA TODAY THAT MAKES PRESIDENT CLINTON BELIEVE WE CAN'T EVEN LIVE UP TO OUR PAST, MUCH LESS COMPETE WITH THE MOST DYNAMIC ECONOMIES IN THE WORLD?

BELIEVE OUR BEST DAYS ARE BEHIND

WHATEVER HIS THINKING, I BELIEVE HE IS PROFOUNDLY WRONG. I BELIEVE THE ONLY BARRIER PREVENTING AMERICA FROM REACHING HER FULL POTENTIAL IS A FAILURE OF LEADERSHIP, NOT A FAILURE OF PEOPLE.
