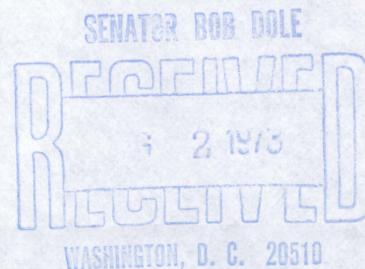


Dear Senator:
