Dear folks:

I'm almost ashamed to write home because it's been about 3½ weeks since we've written and I imagine that you are pretty well disgusted with me.

A lot has happened the past month, we had our 12th week board, I didn't have to go before it however. We lost 13 men that day, Monday we have our 14th week board and will probably lose 10 or 20 more. We have 127 men now out of our original 200 so I'm pretty lucky to still be here I guess.

We had our last physical achievement test 3 weeks ago, I received a superior rating and was 1st in the company I think. We haven't been told how we rated yet but I know that I was pretty high. My grades are getting better now too. I have a "B" average now but we still have 6 more tests before graduation November 18th.

I went to town last week and ordered my clothes so they would be ready if I do graduate. They allow us \$250 for uniforms and believe me that isn't enough to get started. My blouse was \$52.50, short coat

\$55.00, pink shirt and pants 35.00. Green Shirt and pants \$35.00, Garrison Cap \$17.50 and a few other things that finally added up to \$227.50 which leaves me \$22.50 to buy the rest. I want to buy a trench coat and some wool clothes so don't be surprised if I have to write a check. The clothes I bought are being tailor made so they should fit me pretty well.

Received the package Monday "Mom" and everything was as good as usual. The picture of you is really nice, now I have a girl to set on my book shelf. I haven't had one since those was married. Tell "Dad" not to forget to have his taken too.

We have been on Amman the last 4 days. We had 2 night problems that started at 3:00 AM so I haven't had much sleep the past 3 nights. I still have a little cold I guess it will leave gradually. We have one more 6 day Amman our 16th week and then we are through with the wide open spaces for a while.

I haven't been to town to see Pie for 3 weekends or I haven't seen Phil since that first night he got here. Send me his address so that I'll know where to look for him. I imagine that he is pretty busy and probably doesn't have time to do anything but work from one day to the next.

I did go to town last Sunday and had dinner with a friend of Gladys'.

I'll try to call next weekend if I can get a call through without waiting all day. It took me 8^{1/2} hours the last time I called.

How is "Bartel" getting along, I hope he is there when I get home so I can see him. I haven't figured out how I can get home yet. I don't know about the plane situation but if I take a train it will ~~do~~ take me 2 days and nights to get home. I want to get home the fastest way I can even though it costs a little more.
