are really easy but they
have to be for some of the
boys have never gone to
high school or even grade
school. I don't know how
Henry is doing in his tests
but he seems to think that
they are easy so he must be
doing O.K.

I haven't heard anything
about O.C.S. or U.S. T.P. the
last week so I should
be hearing something pretty
soon.

How is everything at home,
I just heard that they were
cutting gas down to 2 gallons
a week instead of 3. I guess
you two will have to start
walking now. It's been so
long since I've ridden in
a car that I don't think I
would know how to act.

I've been feeling good
for a long time now, I guess
the Army life must agree
with me. Hope you two
are feeling O.K.

I have to get a haircut
now so I guess I'd better
go.
