He seems to be doing all right for himself and he looks much better since he has to keep regular hours. I think he deserves more attention than I do until he gets his spirits up. I'd try to write him everyday for he always seems to feel better when he gets letters. Have all the relatives write to him if they will.

I'm glad you put \$25 in the book for me, I'm going to try to add \$5 to it every month so I can buy Grace a ring before too long. I really miss her, but there's not much I can do about it. I guess I should have had her come down, but you should know how conditions are around an Army camp. No place to stay and all that kind of stuff. I may get to see her in November or December for ill be eligible for a furlough then. If I go to O.C.S. I won't get out until April or May.
