

ROCKEFELLER CENTER, NEW YORK CITY

Rockefeller Center is a world-famous group of buildings, 14 ultra modern skyscrapers, situated in New York City and located in the area bounded by Fifth and Sixth Avenues on the East and West and 48th Street and 51st Street on the South and North. Radio City, or the RCA Building, 70 stories high, is the tallest building in the group and faces on Sixth Avenue. The group also includes the 40-storey RKO Building and the International Building. The RCA Building has an observation roof and promenade from which visitors may get an un-obstructed view of New York and environs for a radius of fifty miles. The Buildings include Radio City Music Hall, the largest and most elaborate indoor theatre in the world, seating 6200 people and home of the famous "Rockettes" precision dance corps. Guides are available for a planned tour of the Center which includes the observation roof and The New York Museum of Science and Industry.
