cheese, cheese crackers, sol, shorts, T shirts

here is a good way to pack  
the canned stuff, it takes a can  
of cherries for example, get a tin  
can large enough so that the  
fruit jar will fit inside, wrap  
newspaper around fruit jar and then  
put in tin can, the tin can keeps the  
jar from being broken, I have seen these  
in some other packages.
