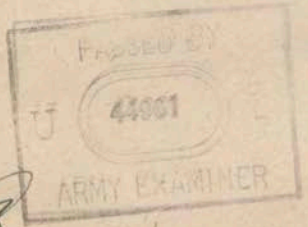
I guess I had better change the subject before I start raving on and on, and I know I could go on for quite a few lines but there is really no need for it, but I can tell you this it is up to my parents and my friends who are at home today to see to it that I get home and the rest of us boys who are stuck over here, there are still men over here who have 42 months service overseas and no sign of a boat to take them home so you can see how for damn the list I am, it is the same old story the Army has you and they don't care if you ever get home, so I say it is up to the public to demand that the Army gets the boys home and I know all the rest of the boys over here feel the same way and I know all of us can't be wrong.

I do hope that Bob gets well soon and
can go home for a few days, as it will
do him more good than anything else in the
world, to get some good home made pie and
ice cream and some good home cooked foods
the way that we like to have it cooked and
none is the only one who can cook to suite
me, and I can hardly wait until I get
home to sit down to a real meal for
a change, well I really haven't said a
lot in this short note and I really don't
have too much to say - except don't worry
about me as I am getting along ok and
feeling just fine and am hoping that
every day brings me a little closer to home,
right now I would venture to say that
I will be lucky to get home by February 26 46
because there are so many boys here who
will go home before me and they aren't
even going as yet, oh there are a few but
very few compared to the number there are to
go. so let's hope they start sending men
home and fast, well I will say so long
for now hoping to hear from all of
you soon + I will try to do my best to
write to all of you.
