NOTES ON EVENT AT SOUTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY STUDENT CENTER

When Senator Dole speaks at the Pre-Hambletonian Dinner, he should recognize:

- 1. Jim Thompson, candidate for Governor against Daley Democrat Joseph Howelett. Thompson is 39 years old and is a former U.S. Attorney from Chicago and is given credit for being successful in cleaning up a great deal of official corruption in Chicago. He could be termed as one of the bright young leaders of the Republican Party. He was leading Howelett in the last poll taken in Illinois.
- Dave O'Neil, candidate for Lt. Governor. Currently serving as Sheriff in a southern Illinois county.
- 3. Bill Scott, candidate for Attorney General. He is an incumbent.
- 4. George Lindberg, candidate for State Comptroller. He is an incumbent.
- 5. Bill Harris, candidate for Secretary of State. He is currently the Minority Leader in the State Senate.
- 6. Pete Prineas, candidate for Congress from the 24th District, running against incumbent Paul Simon.

FOOTNOTES:

Thompson is apparently a very popular candidate and is expected to be a great deal of help in Illinois for the Ford-Dole ticket, and should be treated accordingly.

The Pre-Hambletonian Dinner is an annual event for the Republican Party-approximately 1,000 people will be there at \$12.50 per person.

The Hambletonian is America's most famous trotting race, with a purse this year of \$263,000 and 18 horses. It is frequently called the Kentucky Derby of harness racing.
