Arrangements for the Kansas State Society of Washington, D.C. Dinner-Dance on March 30 have been completed according to Congressman Dole, President of the Society.

Activities will begin at 7:15 P.M. in the Colonial Room of the Mayflower Hotel. Highlights of the evening include: presentation of the Kansas Cherry Blossom Princess, Miss Patricia Lou Thiele of Scott City, Kansas, a senior at Fort Hays Kansas State College; and the presentation of the Outstanding Kansas of the Year award for the first time. The recipient of this award will not be announced until the night of the Dinner-Dance.

Other features will be the appearance of a 16-piece Navy orchestra; miramba selections by Mrs. Bonnie Langdon, formerly of Lucas, Kansas, presently residing in Arlington, Virginia; a 20-minute film on Kansas; and dancing to the music of the Pan Americans.
