Phillipsburg, Kansas - First District Chairman, McDill (Huck) Boyd, has announced former Colorado Governor Dan Thornton will be the principal speaker at a northwest Kansas Republican Rally in Colby, Saturday evening, May 11.

Governor Thornton, long active in Republican politics, served in the Colorado State Senate from 1948 to 1950 and Governor from 1950 to 1954. Thornton was appointed by President Eisenhower to the Commission on Intergovernmental Relations in 1954 and as Special Ambassador to Paraguay in 1958. Governor Thornton presently resides in Englewood, Colorado, and following life long ranching interests, is actively associated with state and national livestock associations.
