Congressman Bob Dole (R-Kansas) today announced his schedule for the Easter Congressional recess.

On Monday, April 15 the Congressman will speak at a joint luncheon meeting of the Concordia, Kansas, Rotary and Kiwanis Clubs. Following the luncheon he will visit Belleville, Mankato, Smith Center, and Russell.

On Tuesday, April 16, Dole has scheduled meetings in his Hutchinson office from 10:00 to 12:00, noon. An "Open House" will be held that afternoon from 1:30 to 4:00 to officially mark the opening of the District Office in Rooms 210-211, Federal Building, in Hutchinson. The public is invited.

Following the "Open House" Dole goes to Barnard, Kansas, as the principal speaker at an evening meeting of the Salt Creek Watershed, District No. 46.

He returns to Washington that night to host the Kansas D.A.R. delegation with Senator Frank Carlson at a breakfast, April 17.

April 18, 19 and 20, Dole along with Cong. John Anderson (Illinois), and Cong. Sherman Lloyd (Utah) will visit North Carolina (Durham, Duke University, University of North Carolina, Greensboro, Winston-Salem, Wake Forest College, Lenoir Rhyne College, Hickory, Shelby, and Gastonia) in conjunction with the Republican Congressional "Paul Revere Panels."
