Congressman Bob Dole (R-Kan.) will be the principal speaker tomorrow evening in Moorhead, Minnesota, at the Minnesota State Young Republican Convention.

Dole indicated he would discuss what he believed to be very questionable conduct by USDA employees in efforts to "sell" the 1964 wheat program to American farmers prior to the May 21 wheat referendum. In his remarks Dole said, "Secretary of Agriculture Orville Freeman must take full responsibility for the expenditure of untold thousands of dollars spent in recent months to propagandize the American farmer at the expense of the general taxpayer. The activity, spearheaded by Freeman, is nothing but referendum politics and in actuality deprives the American wheat producer freedom of choice in the upcoming wheat referendum."

Congressman Dole predicted that failure of the referendum would sound the death knell of this administration's supply management approach to agricultural problems.
