Bob Dole today announced that the U. S. Public Health Service in cooperation with the Kansas State Department of Health will have a special exhibit in the Congressional Booth at the Kansas State Fair in Hutchinson, September 14 thru 19. The exhibit will feature Poison Prevention with emphasis on home, farm and rural hazards of using chemicals such as insecticides, pesticides, etc. In addition to the display which will include a push button question and answer board, a Public Health medical officer will be on hand to answer questions.

This year the Congressional Booth, to be located in the Industrial Building, will be shared by Dole, Senator Carlson and Senator Pearson. "It will feature 'Service to Kansans' and will not be a political booth," Dole said. "The Senators join me in urging visitors to the Fair to stop by the booth, especially in view of the recent interest displayed by Congress over the hazards of misusing certain chemicals."
