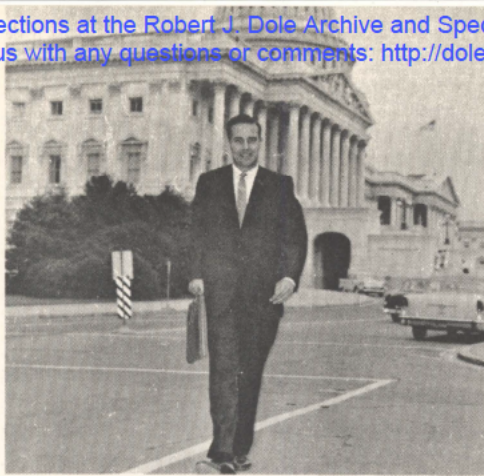

Hutchinson, Kansas, Joe Hunter, Geneseo, General Chairman for the Rep. Bob Dole Dinner to be in the Hutchinson Sports Arena, June 6, announced today that Rep. John Anderson (R), Illinois, will attend the event as a testimonial to his colleague.

Gubernatorial and State Candidates will also be in Hutchinson for the Dole Dinner. They will be introduced during the evening, Hunter said.

"This dinner is being given at the request of the people from over the Big First District who feel they have a Congressman whose integrity is unquestionable", Hunter said.

"Advance ticket sales indicate this will be one of the largest Republican meetings of the 1964 campaign," Hunter continued.

An educational tour for high school juniors and seniors from the 58 counties of the Big First is planned in conjunction with the Dole Dinner.

"This will give the youth of our district an opportunity to visit Hutchinson--to visit places of interest--and to meet, personally, dignitaries at a 5:30 p.m. reception prior to the dinner honoring Rep. Dole", Hunter said.

"Tickets may be purchased from County Chairmen. We're hoping to fill the Arena," Hunter concluded.
