(WASHINGTON) AIDES OF REPRESENTATIVE ROBERT DOLE, KANSAS REPUBLICAN, CONFIRMED TODAY THAT HAROLD STEWART, FORMER PARK POLICE CHIEF IN WASHINGTON, HAS BEEN HIRED BY A GROUP OF REPUBLICAN CONGRESSMEN INVESTIGATING ALLEGATIONS OF WRONGDOING IN THE BOBBY BAKER CASE. THEY ADDED THAT TWO FORMER FBI AGENTS ARE WORKING ON THE CASE. STEWART RETIRED AS HEAD OF THE PARK POLICE LAST YEAR, AND REPORTEDLY HAS GIVEN THE REPUBLICANS CONSIDERABLE INFORMATION CONCERNING BAKER AND HIS RELATIONSHIPS WITH MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THEIR EMPLOYEES.
