Congressman Bob Dole (R. Kansas) announced today he is accepting applications from young men interested in entering service academies for the 1965 class. Applicants must be single, between the ages of 17 and 22 as of July 1, 1965, and must reside in the area covered by the First Congressional District of Kansas.

All applicants will be required to take a Civil Service Examination on October 31, prior to the time they appear before the Academy Screening Board in December. "The Academy Screening Board which proved very successful the past three years will again be utilized in making final selections", Congressman Dole stated.

"Applications are open to the U. S. Military Academy, U. S. Naval Academy, Air Force Academy, as well as the U. S. Merchant Marine Academy. Applications cannot be accepted after October 1, 1964, because of the time needed to process applications".
