Hutchinson - Congressman Bob Dole has announced that President Eisenhower would visit Liberal Sautrday, October 24 for an airport rally.

"He will arrive there from Oklahoma City at 10 a.m., and will leave for Wichita at 11 in time for the luncheon meeting previously scheduled," Dole said.

McDill "Huck" Boyd, Republican First District Chairman, said that Jim French, Seward County Chairman, would be in charge of local arrangements.

"The visit of former President Eisenhower and former Vice-President Nixon to the First District within the space of a week is a tremendous tribute to Congressman Dole and his standing with leaders of the Republican party," Boyd said.

He added that the District organization is indebted to Oliver Hughes, State Chairman, and Sam Mellinger, National Committeeman, for helping work out the details of the visit.

"This is the kind of cooperation from which the Republican party draws its strength," he continued, adding that all state officers, party officials and candidates for state and legislative posts would be invited to attend.
