Congressman Robert J. Dole, (R-1st Dist. Kansas), will be the featured speaker at the annual Lincoln Day Dinner and Rally sponsored by the Orange County Republican Executive Committee, Friday, Feb. 12 at the VFW Post No. 2093, 4444 Edgewater Dr., Orlando.

The dinner is from 5:30 to 7:30 pm., followed by musical entertainment, and at 8 pm. former Congressman August E. Johansen (R-Mich.) will introduce Dole. Tickets for the dinner and rally at \$3 and are available from any member of the Republican committee.

Representative Dole was born and raised in Kansas. He earned an A. B. and L. L. B. degrees from Washburn Municipal University at Topeka. He has served in the Kansas State Legislature and four terms as County Attorney. He was first elected to Congress in 1960. He was re-elected in 1962, and again in 1964. His congressional district is one of the nation's largest and comprises over 60 percent of the area of Kansas (larger geographically than the state of Pennsylvania or New York) and it includes 58 counties and approximately 550,000 people.

Congressman Dole serves on the House Agriculture Committee, and is expected to talk about the administrations handling of the farm labor problem.
