Congressman Bob Dole (R-Kans) returned late Sunday from the Food and Agriculture Organization conference in Rome, Italy, and has a busy schedule for the next several days.

On Tuesday Congressman Dole leaves Washington for Colorado to address the National Beet Growers Federation Wednesday morning, December 8, at the Broadmoor Hotel in Colorado Springs.

On Thursday evening, December 9, he will address a joint meeting of the Atwood, Kansas, Jaycees, Lions, and Rotary Clubs in the Green Room of the Farm Bureau Building.

On Friday, December 10, he will be the main speaker at a Cheyenne County Republican fund-raising dinner in Bird City, Kansas.

Saturday evening, December 11, Congressman Dole will attend a dinner meeting in Ness City, Kansas, honoring First District Republican officers, including the chairman, vice-chairman, secretary, and treasurer from each of the 58 counties in the First District. District Chairman McDill "Huck" Boyd is in charge of arrangements for this meeting. The dinner will be followed by a business meeting at which time a new First District chairman and vice-chairman will be elected.

Sunday afternoon, December 12, Dole will host a buffet dinner honoring members of the First District radio, television, and press media at the Highland Manor Restaurant in Great Bend, Kansas, at 2:00 p.m.

On Monday, December 13, Dole will speak to western Kansas theater owners in Russell, Kansas, at a noon meeting at the Tower Cafe.

Interspersed throughout this schedule will be visits to Goodland, Colby, Norton, Oberlin, Hoxie, Hill City, Quinter, and MaKeeney.

Congressman Dole will be in the District until December 17.
