Washington-Rep. Bob Dole was appointed Friday to the Foreign Operations and Government Information sub-committee of the Committee on Government Operations. Dole will fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Congressman Robert P. Griffin, recently appointed to the Senate by Gov. Romney of Michigan.

Rep. Dole stated, "This is a most important sub-committee, as it has jurisdiction over the Department of State, Agency for International Development, Export-Import Bank, Central Intelligence Agency, and the U. S. Information Agency. I am pleased to become a member of it.

"The sub-committee is well known for its investigations of charges that government agencies have denied or withheld information from those entitled to receive it. In addition to assuring that government officials and government agencies are not restricting the flow of information, the sub-committee also investigates operation of our foreign aid programs; and just recently members of this sub-committee traveled to Viet Nam to investigate charges of fraud and corruption of our foreign aid program there.

"This assignment will necessarily require considerable travel outside the United States. But, in my opinion, the assignment was an opportunity that could not be passed by," Dole said.

The 1st District Congressman continues to serve on the House Committee on Agriculture; is a member of the wheat, livestock and feed grains, family farms, and conservation and credit sub-committees.
