WASHINGTON- Rep. Bob Dole (R.Kans.) announced he is accepting applications from young men interested in entering service academies for the 1967 classes.

Dole said he has two vacancies to the United States Naval Academy, Annapolis, two to the United States Military Academy, West Point, and ten to the Merchant Marine Academy, Kings Point. Coast Guard Academy applicants must apply directly to The Commandant, U. S. Coast Guard, Washington, D. C., before December 1, 1966.

Applicants must be single, between the ages of 17 and 22, as of July 1, 1967, and must reside in the area covered by the First Congressional District.

Dole stated applicants are required to take a Civil Service Examination early in November, and must appear before the Academy Screening Board at its meeting scheduled for Saturday, November 26, on the campus at Fort Hays State College.

"Application forms should be obtained through my District Office," Dole said, "located at 211 Federal Building, Hutchinson, and cannot be accepted after September 1."
