Kansas' First District Congressman, Bob Dole, has announced a busy weekend schedule. Tentatively, he plans to attend the Alf M. Landon Lecture Series at Kansas State University at 10:00 a.m. Thursday morning to hear Governor Ronald Reagan of California. That afternoon Dole will participate in the Miss America Homecoming Parade for Debra Barnes in Pratt, Kansas. Congressman Dole has emphasized his plans for Thursday are tentative and will be cancelled in the event of controversial votes in Congress that day.

On Friday, Dole will attend a buffet luncheon for Miss America at the Governor's Mansion in Topeka. He will then fly to McCook, Nebraska, to attend an afternoon session of the 27th Annual Meeting of The Republican Valley Conservation Association. Friday evening Dole will go to Wichita for a dinner meeting of the Kansas Association for Mental Health Convention.

On Saturday, Dole will address the Kansas Division, UNA-USA (formerly Kansas Unesco) Annual Meeting in Emporia at 10:00 a.m. on the topic, "World Food Crisis, A Problem for Kansans". Saturday evening he will attend a dinner meeting in Meade of Meade Countians and then go on to Johnson, Kansas, to speak at a Southwest Kansas Republican dinner meeting.
