RESOLUTION OFFERED BY CONGRESSMAN BOB DOLE ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 1, 1967 IN THE LIVESTOCK AND FEED GRAINS SUBCOMMITTEE. RESOLUTION DEFEATED ON A STRAIGHT PARTY LINE VOTE OF 6 REPUBLICANS FOR - 8 DEMOCRATS AGAINST.

Resolved that the House Committee on Agriculture, pursuant to the recommendation of the Subcommittee on Livestock and Grains, does herewith recommend that the Secretary of Agriculture take the following administrative actions pursuant to existing legal authority:

- (1) Establish the CCC release price on unrestricted domestic sales of feed grains and soybeans at 100 percent of the parity price plus carrying charges and of wheat at 100 percent of parity minus the value of domestic marketing certificates plus carrying charges; and
- (2) Permit cooperating wheat and feed grain farmers to have warehousing charges on price support loans paid by CCC as is presently the case for cotton; and
- (3) Provide diversion payments to both wheat and feed grain producers participating in the 1968 program; and
- (4) Increase the loan level on corn by 20 cents per bushel to \$1.25 with comparable increases on other feed grains.
