

WASHINGTON, D.C., Nov. 17, 1967 -- Congressman Bob Dole (R-Kans.) today met with Secretary of Agriculture Orville L. Freeman to discuss the world food crisis and the agricultural outlook in India.

Dole is a member of the House Agriculture Committee.

Others attending the breakfast meeting here included John Schnittker, Undersecretary of Agriculture; W. R. Poage (D-Tex.), chairman of the House Agriculture Committee and Jack Miller (R-Iowa), a member of the Senate Agriculture and Forestry Committee.

In 1966, at the request of President Johnson, Dole, Poage and Miller visited India to study agricultural conditions.
