WASHINGTON, D. C., Nov. 20 -- Congressman Bob Dole today announced the first in a series of Senior Citizens' Conferences for western Kansas.

The first conference for citizens of Salina^e, Ottawa, Cloud, Republic, Jewell, Mitchell, Lincoln and Ellsworth counties will be held Saturday, December 9 in Salina. The afternoon program begins at 1:30 p.m. in the Salina high school auditorium.

Dole explained the conferences for all area residents are designed to review and explain state and federal programs affecting persons over age 60. "There have been many questions about existing programs for senior citizens," he said. "Therefore discussion emphasis will be on problems these people have concerning their relation to state and federal agencies and programs."

At the Salina conference, officials of the Social Security Administration, Small Business Administration, Veterans Administration, Kansas State Department of Social Welfare, Kansas Veterans Commission and representatives of other federal and state agencies will join Dole in a panel discussion and question and answer period.

Invitations for the Salina conference will be mailed soon to area citizens.
