WASHINGTON, D.C., Nov. 22 -- Six government officials will speak at the December 9 Senior Citizens Conference in Salina.

The conference, announced this week by Congressman Bob Dole (R-Kans.), will begin at 1:30 p.m. in the Salina high school auditorium.

The panel discussion program, Dole said, is designed to review and explain federal and state programs affecting persons over age 60.

Officials who will join Dole in the afternoon program are: Mrs. Loudell Frazier of Topeka, director, division services for the aging, State Department of Social Welfare; John M. Hubble of Wichita, management assistance specialist, Small Business Administration; Virgil E. Neil of Wichita, Veterans Administration Center; John B. Mathena Jr. of Salina, Kansas Veterans Commission and E. H. Hagan of Salina, district manager, Social Security Administration.

Dole said other conferences will be announced later for other areas of western Kansas.
