WASHINGTON, D.C., Dec. 4 -- U. S. Rep. Bob Dole (R-Kans.) today urged the Secretary of the Interior to release the report on the proposed Round Mound Dam project to the Governor and other state and federal agencies in Kansas for review.

The proposed dam would be located on Big Creek near Ellis.

In a letter to Secretary Stewart L. Udall, Dole said, "This is a project badly needed for municipal water supplies and flood control."
