WASHINGTON, D.C., Dec. 8 -- U. S. Rep. Bob Dole (R-Kans.) will give the keynote speech at the regional Senior Citizens Conference tomorrow in Salina.

The conference begins at 1:30 p.m. in the Salina high school auditorium.

The program, Dole said, is designed to review and explain federal and state programs for persons over age 60.

Officials who will join Dole in the panel discussion program are: Mrs. Loudell Frazier of Topeka, director, division services for the aging, State Department of Social Welfare; John M. Hobbles of Wichita, management assistance specialist, Small Business Administration; Virgil E. Neil of Wichita, Veterans Administration Center; John B. Mathena Jr. of Salina, Kansas Veterans Commission and E. H. Hagan of Salina, district manager, Social Security Administration.

The Rev. Frederic W. Litchman of the Episcopal Christ Cathedral in Salina, will give the invocation. The Rev. Donald J. Weber of the Sacred Heart High School in Salina, will give the benediction.

A movie outlining the medicare program will be shown.

A medley of songs will be presented by the Salina high school Madrigal, under the direction of Paul Ryberg.

Dole said other conferences will be scheduled soon for other western Kansas areas.
