WASHINGTON, D.C., Jan. 3 -- Official records show Congressman Bob Dole was present and voting nearly 96 per cent of the time during the First Session of the 90th Congress which ended Dec. 15, 1967.

The official figures were released recently by W. Pat Jennings, Clerk of the House of Representatives.

Since the Session opened January 10, the Kansas Congressman was absent for 22 of the total 445 roll call votes and quorum calls.

Most of the absences were recorded during Dole's 9-day trip to the Middle East to study the Arab refugee problem following the Arab-Israeli war. Dole is the ranking Republican member of the House Foreign Agricultural Operations Subcommittee.

The Congressional Quarterly estimates the voting average for Congressmen during the First Session was 85 per cent.
