WASHINGTON, D.C., Feb. 12, 1968 -- Congressman Bob Dole today said the second in a series of Senior Citizens Conferences for western Kansas will be held in Hays.

The conference for residents of 17 counties will begin at 1:30 p.m. Friday, March 22 in the National Guard Armory.

Dole explained the conference is designed to review and explain state and federal programs affecting persons over age 60.

Joining Dole in a panel discussion and question and answer period will be officials of the Veterans' Administration, Social Security Administration, Small Business Administration and the Kansas State Department of Social Welfare, State Department of Labor and the Kansas Veterans' Commission.

Dole said invitations to 16,000 persons in Norton, Phillips, Smith, Graham, Rooks, Osborne, Trego, Ellis, Russell, Ness, Rush, Barton, Pawnee, Stafford, Edwards, Kiowa and Pratt counties will be mailed soon.

The first conference was held in December in Salina.
