Congressman Bob Dole today named Richard Hrdlicka of Newton, Kansas, as his 4th Congressional District Dole for Senate Chairman and Mrs. Hobart Hoyt of Lyons as the District Co-Chairman.

Dole, the Republican candidate for the Senate seat being vacated by U. S. Senator Frank Carlson, said Hrdlicka and Mrs. Hoyt will coordinate campaign activities in Marion, McPherson, Rice, Reno, Kingman, Sedgwick, and Harvey Counties.
