WASHINGTON - Rep. Bob Dole (R. Kans.) announced that young men interested in making application for appointment to the various service academies, for the classes entering in 1969, must have their application in to the District Office by August 3, 1968.

Applicants must be single, between the ages of 17 and 22, as of July 1, 1969, and must reside in the area covered by the First Congressional District.

Dole said he has two vacancies at the United States Military Academy, West Point, and two to the Air Force Academy, Colorado. The number of vacancies at the Merchant Marine Academy, Kings Point, will be announced at a later date. Mr. Dole has no vacancies at the Naval Academy, Annapolis, for the class entering in 1969. Coast Guard Academy applicants must apply directly to the Commandant, U. S. Coast Guard, Washington, D. C. before December 1, 1968.

Applicants are required to take a Civil Service examination on August 20, and appear before the Academy Screening Board on Saturday, November 30, 1968, at Fort Hays Kansas State College. Application forms may be obtained at my District Office, located at 101 Federal Building, Great Bend, Dole said.
