WASHINGTON, D.C., Feb. 9 -- U.S. Sen. Bob Dole (R-Kans.) today announced that Frank Mosier, Manhattan, has been named Executive Director of the Kansas Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service (ASCS) State Office in Manhattan.

Mosier, who since 1968 has served as Kansas representative on Dole's staff, has served in an administrative capacity with Kansas State University, the Kansas Farm Bureau, Schilling Institute at Salina and the First National Bank, Manhattan. He succeeds Wendel O. Becraft, Manhattan, who retired this year.

As State Executive Director, Mosier will work with the State ASC Committee supervising operations of the state office staff, and in planning and directing operations of the ASCS throughout Kansas.

Mosier is a graduate of Sheridan Community High School, Hoxie, and of Kansas State University, Manhattan.
