WASHINGTON, D.C., Feb. 11 -- U.S. Sen. Bob Dole (R-Kans.) will be in Kansas Thursday and Friday to discuss some of the major issues confronting the Second Session of the 91st Congress.

Marking the 161st birthday of Abraham Lincoln, Dole will be in Lawrence, Thursday, where he will speak at the Republican Women's Lincoln Day dinner in the Eldridge Hotel at 6:30 p.m. Friday, he speaks in Wichita at a noon joint luncheon in the Broadview Hotel of the Kansas Ready Mix Concrete and Kansas Aggregate Producers' associations.

That evening the Kansas senator has been invited by the Payne County
Republican Central Committee to speak at a dinner in Stillwater, Okla.

Saturday, Dole will be in Los Angeles, Calif., to speak at a dinner sponsored by
the Republican Committee of the 17th Congressional District in Los Angeles County.

A member of the Senate Agriculture and Forestry Committee, Dole will speak Feb. 16 in San Diego, Calif., at a meeting of the Animal Health Division of Chemagro, Corp., an agriculture and livestock chemical company. Feb. 17 he speaks at the Midwest Fertilizer Conference in Chicago before returning that afternoon to Washington, D.C.
