WASHINGTON, D.C., Aug 19 -- Kansas Republican gubernatorial candidate, Kent Frizzell and members of his party worked through a busy and productive schedule in the Capitol city today.

Frizzell, presently Attorney General of Kansas, met with John Mitchell, U.S. Attorney General at 8:30 this morning to discuss matters of mutual concern in Kansas and the nation.

Following the meeting with Attorney General Mitchell was a Kansas delegation meeting at the office of Senator Bob Dole (R-Kans.). After the Presidential meeting, the men of Frizzell's party had lunch with Senators Dole and James Pearson of Kansas in the Senate Dining Room and the ladies dined with Gladys O'Donnell, President of the National Federation of Republican Women.

After their whirlwind day in Washington, the group left for Akron, Ohio where Frizzell is scheduled to meet with
