WASHINGTON, D.C., Oct. 7, 1970 -- U.S. Senator Bob Dole (R-Kans.) today speculated that the vote on further development of the Supersonic Transport (SST) will be delayed until after the November elections.

"The proposal was originally scheduled to be considered last week but was delayed," Dole said.

"The Congressional leadership has announced that we will recess Wednesday, Oct. 14 until Nov. 16. There just won't be time in this remaining week to get to the SST."
