SHELBY, N.C. Oct. 23 -- "A fiscally reckless Congressman is like one who would buy a low-necked gown for a girl shaped like Twiggy," U.S. Senator Bob Dole (R-Kans.) said today. "He doesn't mind an uncovered deficit." Dole spoke in Shelby and Gastonia for Congressman Jim Broyhill.

"Jim Broyhill will lay it on the line," Dole said. "He will level with you.

"He will tell you that government indulgence of inflation is a breach of faith with the American people and he will work to curb that indulgence.

"Inflation is a thief. It steals away the value of savings a working man has put away. It robs him of the purchasing power he has earned.

"Those who support such government spending sprees are like those who want to dance but don't want to pay the piper.

"You pay for that spending in terms of higher prices and higher taxes.

"Jim Broyhill knows that and that's why he supports the President's efforts to curb inflation.

"I served with Jim in the House and he's my kind of legislator. He's the kind of Congressman we need to keep in Washington."
