This seminar was the 25th in a series beginning in 1950 sponsored by the Church of the Brethern. Mr. Tomlinson, associate pastor of the McPherson Church of the Brethern, served as coordinator for the 33-member Kansas delegation.

The group spent three days in New York observing the United Nations before arriving in Washington for the last leg of the trip. While in Washington, the students visited Congress in session, committee hearings, the Supreme Court, the State Department, the White House, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Smithsonian Institution and the Washington offices of the National Council of Churches and the Church of the Brethern.
