WASHINGTON, D.C., August 10, 1971 --- U.S. Senators James B. Pearson and Bob Dole announced today that 45 Kansas colleges and universities have been allocated a total of \$4,314,731 for National Defense Student loans for Fiscal year 1972.

The Senators explained that the Federal monies will provide 90 per cent of the National Defense Student Loan Funds of the participating colleges and universities and that each institution will provide the remaining 10 per cent in institutional matching monies. Pearson and Dole said that more than 11,000 Kansas students will benefit from the monies made available under Title II of the National Defense Education Act of 1958.
