WASHINGTON, D.C., August 16, 1971 ---- The offices of Senators James B. Pearson and Bob Dole, Kansas Republicans, announced that federal funds for the State Park Development Program in Kansas have been increased by \$283,258 making a total of \$1,471,364 available for parking, roadway and sewage systems improvements in nine state parks.

The funds, the Senators explained, were granted from the Bureau of Outdoor Recreation of the Department of Interior and will be dispursed in Kansas through the Kansas Parks and Resources Authority.

The funds announced today will be matched by the state of Kansas. The total additional funds will be used to complete Phase Five of the Kansas State Park Development Program, a project to develop outdoor recreation facilities in state parks.

Parks included in the project are: Fall River-Toronto, Pomona, Lovewell, Cheney, Milford, Perry, Crawford, Scott and Prairie Dog.
