WASHINGTON, D.C., Sept. 1, 1971 ----- The offices of U.S. Sen. James B. Pearson and Bob Dole, Kansas Republicans, announced today the award of a \$1,182,764 federal grant to the city of Leavenworth from the Environmental Protection Agency.

The grant funds announced today will be added to an existing sewer treatment works grant for that city bringing the total to \$2,198,504.

The title of the project is "Modification and improvement to existing water treatment plant and addition of secondary treatment facility."

The total estimated cost of the project is \$3,078,000.
