WASHINGTON, D.C., Sept. 3, 1971---- U.S. Senators James B. Pearson and Bob Dole, Kansas Republicans, announced today that an advance action grant from the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration has been awarded to the Governors Committee on Criminal Administration.

The LEAA grant is in the amount of \$903,200.

The advance grant funds will be used to support projects undertaken during fiscal year 71, designated by that year's comprehensive plan.

The Senators explained that the full annual action grant for 1972 is contingent upon approval of the 1972 FY comprehensive plan, which has not yet been approved, and that the advance grant is to provide a continuity in funds during the interim.
