WASHINGTON, D.C., Sept. 22, 1971 ----U.S. Sen. Bob Dole (R-Kans.) met with Ness City man, Ray F. Uehling, recently, to congratulate him upon his appointment to serve on the National Advisory Committee on Wheat, Feed Grain and Soybeans. The committee is composed of members representing a cross-section of producers, farm groups and associations and the trade and industry.

Uehling, former president of the Kansas Association of Wheat Growers, has served on the Farm Credit Advisory Committee of the 9th Farm Credit District. He is a past president of the board of the Federal Land Bank in Ness City.

Presently, he serves on the Farmers Home Administration state committee and is a director of the Kansas State Bank.

The western Kansas farmer was in Washington recently attending National Advisory Committee meetings to consider feed grain programs for 1972.

Another Kansan, Robert L. Rawlins, of Holton, was named earlier to the 31-member committee.
