U.S. Sen. Bob Dole (R-Kans.) learned today that Tony Mesa of Garden City, Kans. will be appointed to the State Advisory Committee for the Farmers Home Administration for a three year period.

The official announcement is expected to be made later this week by the Farmers Home Administration, Dole said.

Mesa, a 50 year resident of Garden City, is a motel owner and operator. He is a member of the State Chamber of Commerce, the Small Business Administration Advisory Council, Garden City Human Relations Commission, the Garden City area Chamber of Commerce and the Finney County Mental Health Association.

The State Advisory Committee, with the State Director of FmHA, serves to advise on matters relating to the adapting of national and FmHA policies to local conditions, various aspects of agricultural credit in Kansas, and the coordination of supervised credit programs with the programs of other federal and state agencies.

The State Committee is composed of Mesa; Ray F. Uehling, Ness City; Charles K. DeForest, Peabody; Mrs. Roy W. Schurter, Eureka; R.C. Rolff, Lorraine, and Dr. Robert Bohannon, Manhattan.
