WASHINGTON, D.C., Dec. 29, 1971 ----- U.S. Senators James B. Pearson and Bob Dole, Kansas Republicans, announced today that the Environmental Protection Agency has granted \$17,977 to the Topeka-Shawnee County Health Department to continue a project started in August 1971 to establish a air pollution control program in Shawnee County.

The EPA funds announced today by the Kansas Senators will carry the project through the coming year. The Air Pollution Control Establishment grant is scheduled to terminate December 31, 1973.
